

Have you changed the way you study for Math 118 over the course of the semester? If so, how?

- Yes, In the beginning of the semester I did not practice as much on a daily basis as I do now. I still do all the problems, but I have to spread them out over a number of days so that I do not get overwhelmed. I study for tests over longer periods of time now.
- Yes, instead of just reading the book over and over again - I will try a problem and see how far I can get and then think of ways I could go from there - if that requires going back to the book I'll go back to the book, or going back to class notes.
- I started going to the Math Learning Center more often.
- I have just learned that the practice problems really help and that doing them will only benefit you
- Yes. I study overall a great deal more than I thought I would have to.
- Yes, doing my homework as soon as we completed the corresponding section in class
- Yes. I think differently about math now. It isn't just crunching numbers.
- yes i now review my lecture notes more.
- I did change the way I study for Math 118 over the course of the semester. I am trying to keep up with the homework problems and at the same time trying to study every night !
- learned 2 study with others and 2 ask questions
- I haven't really changed my study habits for 118 because I study everything including my notes, practice problems, and homework assignments. I study these things individually and seek help at the Math Learning Center if I have trouble with any problems. This has worked for me so far so I keep applying it.
- Yes. I started going to the Math office! and studying in groups!
- Yes, I review each each section after every class and do most of the assigned problems.
- Yes, i came into the course not really knowing how to study. Now, i have an idea of how to use the problems from the book and the notes to prepare for the tests
- I was able to start off focused and was more or less able to maintain that focus. As the semester wore on, I wasn't able to devote as much time as I originally had to the work, but I ended up having to make time.
- Not really. I completed more of my homework in preparation.
- Yes, I have tried to study for my test at least a week and half before they were given out, I have tried to ask more specific questions about things I did not understand, etc.
- Now I study more- do practice problems and read over notes.
- Yes, I now have to think about what things mean as well as the technique behind them.
- yes, instead of just doing problems over and over again, i review concepts and then apply them to specific problems
- Somewhat, because in the beginning I did mostly everything by myself, but now I think I work more in groups with my hallmates.
- Yes, I do more homework problems.
- Yes, I focus more on word problems which are very difficult for me. I try to analyze each problem accurately.
- I didn't, but I should have. Again, I should have kept up with the reading and homework assignments and then I think I would have been in better shape when it was time to study for a test.
- I don't know that I changed as much as I would have liked. Like I said, I think that I should have been more diligent with day to day assignments.
- Yeah... just looking over the material and reinforcing it by doing the problems until I understood. It's all about doing the problems!
- Yes, before i would just look over but now i have to read and do example problems or i dont get all the information i need to do well on the tests

Did you take advantage of the resources of the Mathematics Learning Support Center this semester? If so, how often (once a week, twice a week, occasionally, etc.), how useful do you think these resources were for you, and in what ways were they helpful?

- I went to the MLSC about 2x a week. I dont think that I would be able to do as well in this class without the learning support center.
- I used MIC to my full advantage, but I didn't use the math learning support center very often - but when I did they were very helpful and knowledgeable.

- Yes, occasionally. They were somewhat helpful.
- I generally went to the Learning Center about twice a week, and they were super useful.
- Yes, I visited twice this semester. The tutors really showed me other ways of approaching problems and also helped refresh algebra skills I had forgotten.
- Yes! They were very helpful. They really helped untangle the math in my head.
- Yes, two to three times a week. They were very helpful and it motivated me to get some work done.
- I've been a few times and it was very helpful
- Yes. Twice a week or more usually. They were very helpful in encouraging us to re-do our problems and check them over ourselves.
- Yes once or twice every other week.
- yes, once. very useful
- I would visit the Math Learning Center about 2 to 3 times a week some weeks. It mainly averages out to 2 visits per week. I thought this resource was very beneficial to me because the learning assistants helped me when I had problems and helped me understand difficult concepts.
- Yes Every Sunday evening from 6-8pm! Very helpful!
- I really benefitted from the tutoring at the Math Learning Support Center. I visited the center once or twice a week on average. It was good to be able to go step by step through problems with tutors and to concepts explained to me again to reinforce what I learned in class.
- Yes, I went to the learning center once or twice a week.
- Yes, I went an average of once a week. I rarely went at first and then went much more frequently toward the end of the semester. Most of the time they were helpful, explaining the concepts I didn't understand, and helping me with problems, etc. They usually made sure I understood the ideas and not just got the answer to the problem.
- I visited the tutors a few times the semester and they were very helpful. I think knowing that they're there is a comforting thing to keep in the back of your mind, so you don't completely stress out about homework or EGrade.
- The Math Center was amazing!!! I sort of went sporadically, usually a few days or so before an exam. They were always helpful and explained the problems very well!!!
- No. I wish I had though.
- Yes. Once about every other week. It was helpful to talk to a student and have them help me with the problems that arose in my problem solving.
- Yes I visited the Mathematics Learning Support Center very frequently (sometimes 2-3 times a week). The resources were useful and the tutors could sometimes explain things to me a lot better, which was a big help!
- Yes, occasionally. They were useful, but sometimes the number of tutors was inadequate.
- I used the Mathematics Learning Support Center about once a week during the middle of the semester but less towards the end. I found them very helpful when I came in with a problems set and homework problems.
- I went twice. It was very useful.
- Occasionally I went to the Support Center. They were very helpful in teaching me other ways to think of the problem.
- Yes, I went to the MLC about at least twice a week. I found these resources to be very helpful for this course.
- Yes, about once a week and these resources were VERY useful! All the tutors were helpful with solving difficult homework sets as well as preparations for tests!
- Yes, they were very helpful. When I left, I understood what I came for.
- Yes, I went to the Math Learning center about once a week. It was very helpful. I received personal attention on key problems.
- I saw the tutors about once a week or so.
- Yes I did go occasionally, but not as often as I wish. I have several things going on and so my time available for the Math Lab was limited, but the few times I went was helpful. They did not give answers, rather, let you come to your own with them, which helps stretch my brain!
- I went and got help a couple of times. They were very nice and made you comfortable especially if you were there for a first time.
- Not really. I only went once or twice. The tutors were pretty helpful... they helped me look at the problems in another perspective so that I could understand it better.
